The photos I have included with my email demonstrates the crowded parking lot behind the Mountain View Center and adjoining streets. The cars in the parking lot are not all from Mountain View businesses, they are over flow from the surrounding community. Most low income family's have multiple vehicles. The Raton/El Toro Road low income apartments park their cars and trucks up and down La Vaca street. Drive by any evening and see what Raymond Way is about to become. The Mountain View site is the wrong area for this project. I'm sure there were other better sites in Lake Forest for this project. I am concerned that the Council was pushed into this site by National Community Renaissance vs. suggesting a more suitable location for them to build. 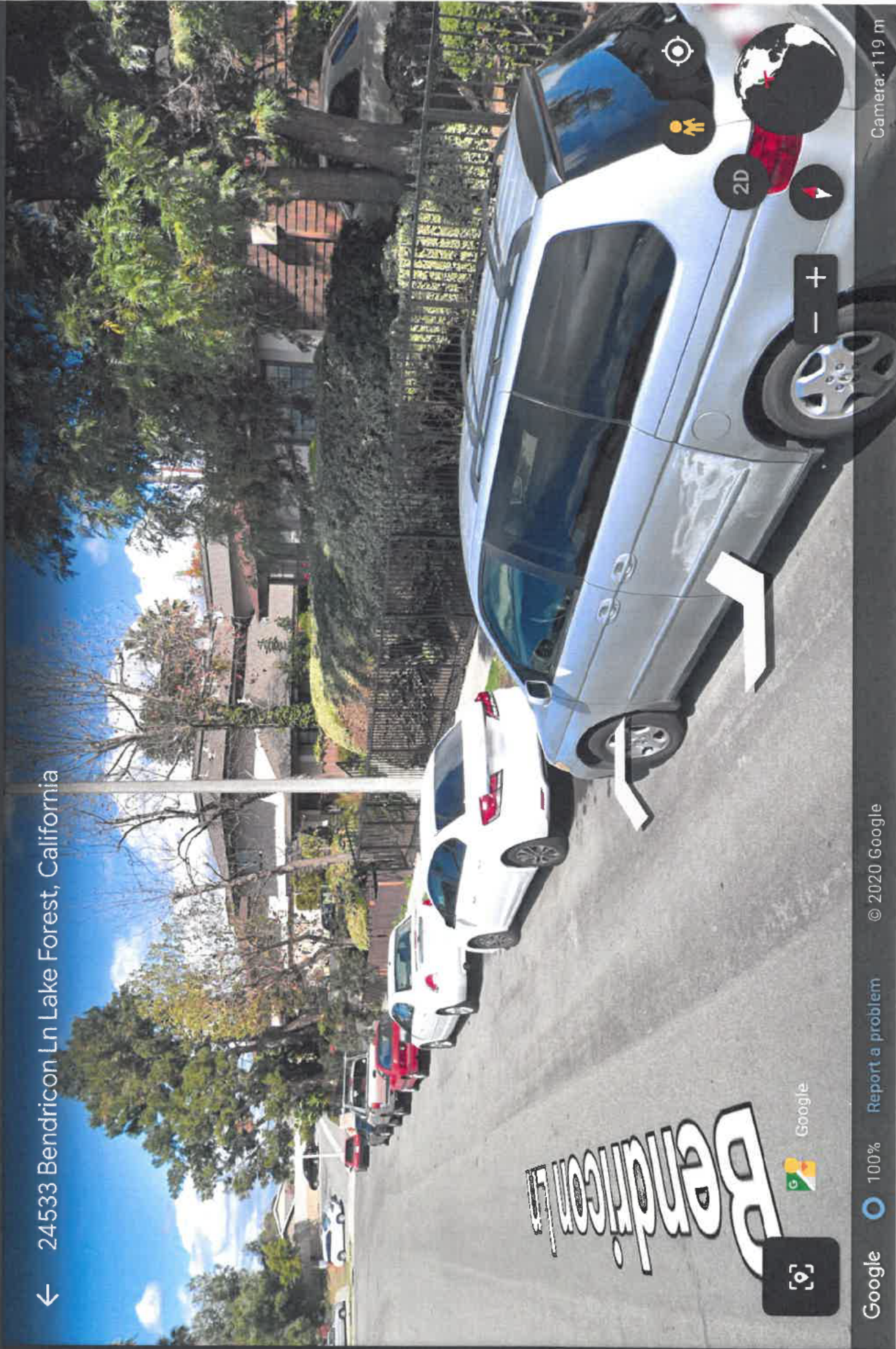

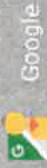

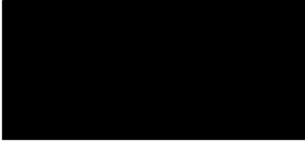
