2. RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE NOVEMBER 8, 2022
ELECTION

Attached for the City Council's review and adoption is the final resolution which includes the official election results of the November 8, 2022, General Election. Attached to the resolution is Exhibit A – the Certificate of the Registrar of Voters documenting the Result of the Canvass of the General Election returns. This information was received from the Orange County Registrar, Bob Page after the posting of the City Council agenda.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE
FOREST, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACTS OF THE
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8,
2022, DECLARING THE RESULT, AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS
AS PROVIDED BY LAW**

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Lake Forest, California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 5 adopted December 20, 1991, authorizing consolidation with the County, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE FOREST, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of vote by mail ballots casts was 15,298; that the whole number of vote center ballots casts was 2,947, making a total of 18,245 ballots cast in the City.

SECTION 2. That the names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

District 2: Suzy Betz, Bob Stuart and Benjamin Yu

District 3: Scott Voigts

District 4: Mark Tettermer

SECTION 3. In accordance with Elections Code Section 10262, the City Clerk certified the results to the City County. The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons named in Section 2 above, are listed in Exhibit "A" attached to this Resolution.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that the following candidates were elected as Members of the City Council for the full term of four years:

District 2: Benjamin Yu

District 3: Scott Voigts

District 4: Mark Tettemer

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) the measures voted upon; (3) The names of the persons voted for; (4) For what office each person was voted for; (5) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person and for and against each measure; and (6) The total number of votes given to each person and for and against each measure.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
